The Mapesbury Clinic is a pioneering scheme started and developed at The Minister Centre; supported and funded by the London Councils (ALG) and the Big Lottery Fund. The clinic is run and managed by highly experienced staff, trained accredited and registered counsellors/psychotherapists.

The Mapesbury Clinic's, counselling and psychotherapy provision is culturally and linguistically appropriate. The service is for refugees, asylum seekers, people in exile who are aged 18 and over and residing in one of the London boroughs.

We are seeking competent men & women from different cultural and linguistic backgrounds:

- With previous training or qualification in counselling and related fields or students in final year (3rd and above yr or 2nd yr if you are a Post Graduate Trainee) of counselling/psychotherapy studies.
- Who are caring, sensitive people who would like to volunteer for this challenging and stimulating work.
- We are particularly seeking people who speak **Arabic, Farsi, Albanian and Turkish**

In exchange for your services the Minster Centre will reimburse your travel expenses and provide fortnightly group supervision for all counselling/psychotherapy you that will provide as part of professional development and observing and implementing BAC/BACP/UKCP requirements.
